“Igniting Potential”

The Rumson School District ignites the potential of its learners by growing, inspiring, and cultivating personal excellence academically, socially and emotionally.

Purpose: Homework Club (HWC) is a positive after-school program for students who need assistance with homework. During the 45-minute session, HWC students work with a staff member to complete assignments in a variety of academic subjects. HWC provides an opportunity for students to grow their knowledge, skills, and understanding with help from certified teachers. It's a safe, extended learning and practice time, free from distraction.

Homework Club is *not* :

- a drop-in between sporting events
- a holding area between school and outside activities
- A time for socializing

Time: 3:15-4:00

Days: Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday
(no ½ days)

Duration: 83 days max starting on November 1 and running through June 13.

Students may enroll for the year or by marking period.

Behavioral Expectations:

1. Students arrive by 3:15 and sign in
2. Students bring with them all necessary materials to complete work, including a book to read.
3. Students complete a daily goal check as an exit ticket.
4. Students behave respectfully with other students, teachers, the school building, and materials during HWC.
5. Students read in their independent books when they finish their homework.
6. Students may bring a healthy snack and clean up after.
7. School rules apply; that is, no music, no computer games, and no phones during HWC.

Consequences:

When students do not follow the expectations, they will be reminded about our rules and have an opportunity to reflect on what happened and what they will do moving forward. A copy of their written reflection will be shared with home and the main office.

In the case that this is not effective, the HWC teacher will make a referral to Mrs. Gibbons and call home.

If negative behavior continues, the student will be asked to not return to HWC.
