The Rumson School District ignites the potential of its learners by growing, inspiring, and cultivating personal excellence academically, socially and emotionally.

Purpose: Homework Club is for students to get assistance on any homework from a staff member from any academic subject. This is an opportunity for students to gain more knowledge and skills with certified teachers to better prepare them for academic success.

Homework Club is *not* a drop in between sporting events, or a holding area between school and outside activities.

Students **MUST** bring something to do at all times. It is not time to socialize and distract others.

Students can enroll for the year or by marking period.

After School Homework Club

Time: 3:15-4:00 PM

Days: Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday
(no ½ days)

Below are behavior guidelines and expectations:

1. Students arrive no later than 3:15 and must sign in at the very beginning.

2. Students **MUST** have all necessary materials to complete work.

3. Students will complete a goal sheet every day as a ticket out.

4. Students will respect all students, mentors and staff.

5. Students should have a book to read when they finish their homework.

6. Students may bring snacks, but it is important that they clean up after themselves. IF they abuse this privilege, then they will be asked not to bring snacks until they can be responsible.

7. All school rules apply. This means: NO MUSIC, COMPUTER GAMES OR PHONES.

If students don't follow any of the behavior expectations and school rules, then the following will occur:

a) The first time the students do not follow the expected behavior and school rules, the student will receive a warning and be reminded of the appropriate behavior for homework club from the appropriate teachers.

b) The second time the students do not follow the expected behavior and school rules, the teacher will share with Mrs. Gibbons, a call home will occur, and the student will be spoken to with the appropriate administrator.

c) The third time the students do not follow the expected behavior and school rules, they will receive a final call home and be asked to not return to homework club.
