

National Junior Honor Society Induction Ceremony



On October 18, 2018, the newest members of the Forrestdale School Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society (NJHS) were inducted. The ceremony was in the Forrestdale Gym with a reception that followed. Student representatives including chapter Vice President: Sydney Carroll, Secretary: Payton Haley, and Treasurer: Michael Chen conducted the ceremony by guiding the students through the NJHS pledge and handing out membership cards and pins.

The new members included seventh and eighth grade students who had achieved academic and social excellence during the past school year. In order to be eligible for membership the students must have a 92 or above average in all classes during the first three marking periods of the previous school year and be active members of the school and local community. The NJHS students are expected to uphold the five pillars of scholarship, citizenship, leadership, service, and character and serve as models for their peers. Once accepted, students must keep their grades above a 92 average and perform at least 20 hours of community service. The newly inducted students are then responsible for a group service project.
