Dear Parents and Community,

At the November 18th Board of Education meeting the Rumson Borough Board of Education accepted the resignation and retirement of Mrs. Denise Friedmann, School Business Administrator/Board Secretary, and the resignation of Mrs. Amy Romano, District-Wide Assistant Principal. Mrs. Romano has accepted the position of Principal at the Knollwood School in Fair Haven. Both Mrs. Friedmann and Mrs. Romano's resignations are effective December 31, 2015.
